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UNDERGRADUATE PLACEMENT SUMMARY • CLASS OF 2012

Salary and placement data for the Lehigh University Class of 2012 was obtained through a survey of the students who received bachelor's degrees between January and December 2012. The survey was conducted January 2012–January 2013 by Career Services. Of the 1,022 bachelor's degree recipients, 90% responded to the survey. Typical response to similar surveys conducted at other colleges and universities nationwide is 60–65%.

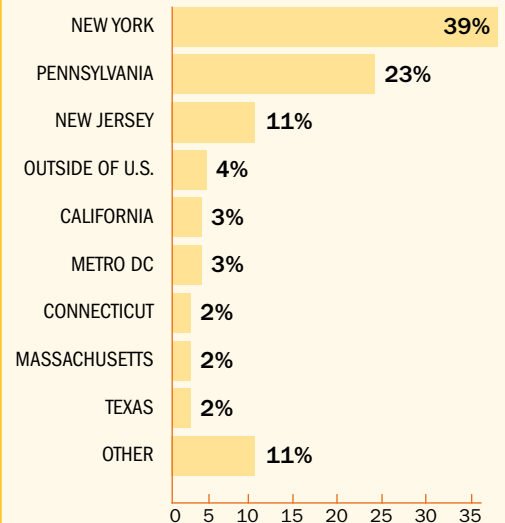

30% of the respondents from the Lehigh Class of 2012 chose to attend graduate or professional school. This 30% also includes Lehigh President's Scholars.

86% of the Lehigh class of 2012 candidates who applied to allopathic (M.D.) medical schools with grade point averages (GPAs) of 3.68 or better and an MCAT score of 30 or above were accepted. (3.68 GPA/ 30 MCAT were the national averages of students accepted into medical schools.)

Typically, nationwide 78% of seniors who applied to law school were accepted to one or more schools. At Lehigh, the acceptance rate is approximately 89%.
